

Proposal for the creation of a dedicated Narcotics Cell in Bihar State has been under consideration for some time. In recent years, traffick of narcotics drugs from Nepal to other parts through this state has been noticed on Bihar-Nepal Border. On the other hand, districts of Buxar, Rohtas, Bhabhua and Bhojpur have witnessed growing illegal trade of opium and allied drugs on Bihar-U.P. Border.

For the effective enforcement of provisions under N.D.P.S. Act and monitoring of cases, a narcotics cell has been functioning under the economic offences wing of C.I.D. However, in view of urgency a Dedicated Narcotics Cell has been created which should function not only as a full time agency for action against drug traffickers, but should also as the nodal and co-ordinating agency for maintaining liaison and co-ordination with the other agencies, units and also with the Narcotics Control Bureau at the central level.

On the suggestion of Narcotics Control Bureau, the Dedicated Narcotics Cell will function under C.I.D. at Patna. Since during the last few years, large scale seizure of Narcotics Drugs has been noticed on Bihar-Nepal and Bihar-U.P. Borders, it has also been decided to setup operational teams at Muzafferpur, Purnea and Dehri. These operational teams will be headed by gazetted Police officers of the rank of Additional S.P./ Dy. S.P.. Each Operational Team will consist of Intermediate supervisors of the rank of Inspector/Sub-Inspector who/ not only collect intelligence of illegal trade in Narcotic Drugs but also ensure enforcement

Other personnel including drivers and wireless operators will be provided along with the vehicles and wireless sets, when these are made available to Operational Teams. Efforts are being made to arrange modern equipments like Night vision benoculars, Autofocus Camera, P.C. Computer, Xerox machine, O.H. projector and Test Kits at the Headquarters as well as for the Operational Teams, So that these can function effectively.

With the Creation of Dedicated Narcotic Cell, the responsibility of district Ss.P. Will not be over and they are expected to continue their efforts against Drug Trafficking and provide assistance in the form of vehicles and armed forces etc., as and when required by the operational teams. Needless to add the officers of Narcotics Cell will continue to be in close contact with the district police and will also apprise the district Ss.P. with important intelligence, required for effective control of drug abuse and Trafficking

A periodical review of the performance and liaison will be conducted every month and report submitted to I.G., C.I.D., D.G. of Police, Narcotics Control Bureau and other agency.
